Minutes

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

a. ROLL CALL

Present were Councilors John Caruso, Maurice Day, Chris Cookson, and Frank Roma. Chris Grotton was absent. Mr. McClung welcomed Mr. Roma to the Town Council.

b. Appointment of Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson.

Maurice Day motioned to appoint Chris Grotton to continue as chairperson. The motion was seconded by Frank Roma and unanimously approved with a 4-0 vote.

Chris Cookson motioned to appoint Maurice Day as deputy chairperson. The motion was seconded by John Caruso and unanimously approved with a 4-0 vote.

At this point, Mr. McClung turned the meeting over to Deputy Chairperson Maurice Day.

c. CITIZEN INPUT - OPPORTUNITY FOR

No one in the audience chose to address the Council.

d. [01-23-01] Katie Allen to present the new GOGLENBURN! app now available.

Office Assistant Katie Allen stated that this is a GOGov app that the Town of Glenburn is now with. It is another way to notify and communicate with the citizens of Glenburn on things that are going on within the town. It is a direct link to any State of Maine website that we use and to any town website or town materials that we use. It can be a direct push notification on cellphones, and it can pop up like a text message. It is a bit more accessible than Facebook where you have to go searching for the information.

Mr. Day thanked Katie for her presentation tonight and presented her with a gift for stepping up to moderate the town's Annual Town Meeting in June when our regulator moderator could not attend.

e. [01-23-02] Rec Director, Carey Besse to present update for recreation department.

Mrs. Besse stated that pee wee baseball had 18 kids and ended with a great season. The spring/summer track is still going, and participation has doubled since last year. Day camp is small this summer, and the need for camp instructors was lower than last year. The first Lakeside Landing Summer Concert did extremely well. Both vendors were pleased with the sales. July 22nd is the next concert.

Mr. Day thanked Carey for her presentation and presented her with a gift for 25 years of service with the Town of Glenburn.

f. [01-23-03] Council discussion, to see what action the Town Council will take regarding accepting a Library donation in the amount of \$28.

Frank Roma motioned to accept a \$28.00 donation to the Glenburn Library. The motion was seconded by Chris Cookson and unanimously approved with a 4-0 vote.

Chris Cookson motioned to accept the June 8, 2023 minutes as written. The motion was seconded by John Caruso and unanimously approved with a 4-0 vote.

Manager/Council Items/Other Business

Mr. McClung stated that because of the revised schedule, the next Town Council Meeting will be July 27th which is three weeks from tonight. In August, Council meetings will be on the 17th and the 31st.

The extended Marijuana Moratorium Ordinance expires in September. Mr. McClung would like to get a draft ordinance together and proceed with the approval process.

There are a couple of grant opportunities currently being worked on. One is for a boat ramp and one is potentially for park trails around the recreation area.

Mr. McClung has spoken to Chief Lavoie, and they would like to get the EMS committee going again for a strategic plan.

Chris Cookson motioned to adjourn. The motion was seconded by John Caruso and unanimously approved with a 4-0 vote, and the July 6, 2023 Town Council Meeting was adjourned at 7:17 PM.
