MINUTES

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

a. ROLL CALL

Present were Councilors Chris Grotton, Maurice Day, John Caruso, and Frank Roma. Chris Cookson was absent.

b. CITIZEN INPUT - OPPORTUNITY FOR

No one in the audience chose to address the Council.

c. [24-06-01] Council discussion, to see what action the Town Council will take regarding signing the Warrant Articles for the special town meeting being held September 26, 2024.

Mr. Caruso made a motion to sign the warrant for the Special Town Meeting, Mr. Day seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

d. [24-06-02] Council discussion, to see what action the Town Council will take regarding signing an extended snow plow contract with D.P. Morrissey.

Mr. McClung presented the Council with the finalized contract. Mr. Day made a motion to accept, seconded by Mr. Caruso. The motion passed unanimously.

e. [24-06-03] Council discussion, to see what action the Town Council will take regarding selling the old first responder vehicle.

Mr. McClung informed the Council that the Town of Milford had an interest in the vehicle, had received a grant and offered \$4,500 to purchase it. It is his recommendation that we accept the offer and keep the vehicle in service. Mr. Caruso made a motion to approve the sale, Mr. Day seconded. This passed unanimously.

f. [24-06-04] Council discussion, to see what action the Town Council will take regarding the disposal of the fire engine pump and generator.

The pump and generator were replaced a few years ago. They are no longer of use to the town. Mr. Caruso made a motion to allow the Town Manager to dispose of this equipment. This was seconded by Mr. Roma. Motion passed unanimously.

g. [24-06-05] Council discussion, to see what action the Town Council will take regarding signing the warrant articles provided by UTC for the November 5th election.

UTC did not have the warrant articles ready for tonight's meeting. Mr. Caruso made a motion to table this article until the next meeting, seconded by Mr. Day. The motion to table passed unanimously.

h. [24-06-06] Treasurer's Warrant #6 – APPROVAL OF

Mr. Caruso made a motion to accept; Mr. Day seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

i.[24-06-07] Minutes of August 29, 2024, Regular Council Meeting APPROVAL OF,

Mr. Day made a motion to approve; Mr. Caruso seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

Manager/Council Items/Other Business

Mr. McClung informed the Council that Fire Chief Lavoie has resigned. Former Chief Jordan McLaughlin has stepped in as interim chief.

We have not received the soil test yet on the lot on Cedar Breeze North, Mr. McClung is expecting that next week. After this is received, we can move forward on deciding how to proceed.

The field behind the tennis court has been surveyed. This was done so we have a layout of where the skating rink can be placed.

We have applied for a grant for LED stoplights for a few dangerous intersections.

Mr. Caruso made a motion to adjourn, Mr. Roma seconded. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
