**A note from the Glenburn Rec Director regarding driving and parking at the Glenburn Rec Fields;**

Parents and Fans of all the youth athletics held at the fields on Nadia Dr,

As we start to plan for winter activities, I want to remind you to please **slow down** when driving into any of our facilities. There are children moving around everywhere, and as we plan more outdoor activities, there are likely to be even more children than usual.

**Parking:** be considerate when parking – please make sure we have room for everyone and **NO PARKING on the ROAD Sides anywhere!!** This clogs up traffic flow and makes for unsafe conditions.

We all really appreciate your cooperation.

**ALL OUR PARKS ARE OPEN**

Operation hours are ½ hr before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset. This includes Rec Fields at Naida Dr, Lakeside Landing, West Side Parks at Ohio St, and Butler Park at the town office. The Play area at the school is open as well; however the hours here are from the time school ends until ½ hr past sunset.

For a complete list of our park rules and regulations stop by the town office and request a copy.

Always do your part and clean up after yourselves. We all take pride in our town parks and keep them nice and tidy for all to enjoy. For now, make sure to bring your own sanitizer 😊

**DOG LOVERS,** your pets are welcome at our parks, however, PLEASE PLEASE, clean up after them. That is your responsibility and **ALWAYS** have them **on a leash**. It is a law in the State of ME. When at Lakeside Landing, keep **dogs off the beach** where the children play and swim. We all appreciate your cooperation.
