SEX OFFENDER NOTIFICATION

Dear Sir or Madam:

The State Bureau of Identification (SBI) is required by law to maintain a Sex Offender Registry. Pursuant to Title 34A MRSA ss11001-11144 and ss 11201 - 11252, individuals who are convicted of certain crimes are required to register their address with SBI after they have been discharged from any State Correctional Facility or County jail or at the time of sentencing if no period or institutional confinement is to be served.

The Penobscot County Sheriff's Office has been notified that **Thomas Thompson, DOB: 12/28/1948**, meets those requirements. We are providing this information to you because he currently resides in your community. The Department of Corrections utilizes a Risk Assessment Tool, which divides Registered Sex Offenders into 4 categories with respect to the risk that they may re-offend within the next 10 years. Those categories are; unknown, low, medium and high risks. The named individual is currently classified as an **UNKNOWN** risk.

The Penobscot County Sheriff's Office reminds you that Registered Sex Offenders have a right to live where they want as long as they comply with the conditions of their probation. Under Maine's laws, you have a right to know where that residence is.
